"You've recently added a new medication. Sometimes a new medication is prescribed to treat side effects from another medication. If that's the case, changing your original medication may prevent the side effects, so the additional medication may not be needed."

"If you are on migraine therapy, there is a preventive medication that could help you take lower doses of your acute migraine medication, which is very expensive. With the preventive medication, there is less chance of rebound headaches—headaches caused by taking too much acute medication or by taking it too often."

"Is staying on your heart medicine important? Consider this: Lowering your blood pressure with medication can help reduce your risk of heart attack by up to one-quarter, stroke by more than one-third, and heart failure by over one-half!"
